

## **Cold or Flu?**

Use the checklist below to help determine if it's a cold or the flu. (Seasonal flu and H1N1 flu have the same symptoms)

SYMPTOM	COLD		FLU
Fever	Rare		Usually high (100°F - 102°F)
Headache	Rare		Common
General aches and pains	Slight		Common, often severe
Fatigue, weakness	Sometimes		Common, up to 2-3 weeks
Extreme exhaustion	Never		Common, at illness onset
Stuffy nose	Common		Sometimes
Sneezing	Common		Sometimes
Sore throat	Common		Sometimes
Chest discomfort, cough	Mild - Moderate hacking cough		Common, can be severe
Treatment	Antihistamines, decongestants, Non-steroidal anti- inflammatory medication		Antiviral medication prescribed by a doctor (Tamiflu or Relenza)
Prevention	Wash hands often Avoid close contact with ill people		Annual vaccine Wash hands often Avoid close contact with ill people
Complications	Sinus Congestion Middle ear infection Asthma		Bronchitis Pneumonia, can be life threatening
