

Get to Know the Canvas Parent App

When students are learning remotely, parents become an even more essential part of the learning process. To support your student in achieving success, the Canvas Parent app allows you to check their grades, view due dates, read assignment instructions, and communicate with teachers. You can even receive a notification when your student earns a certain score on an assignment or quiz!



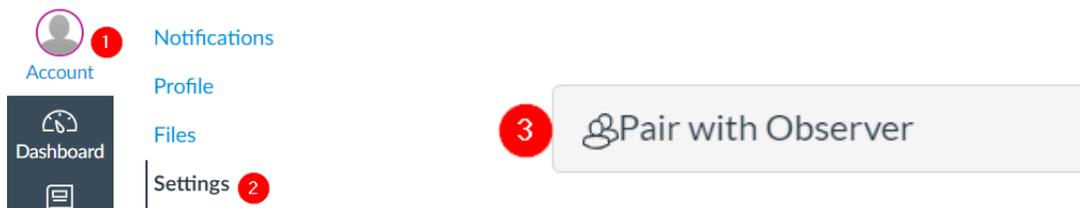

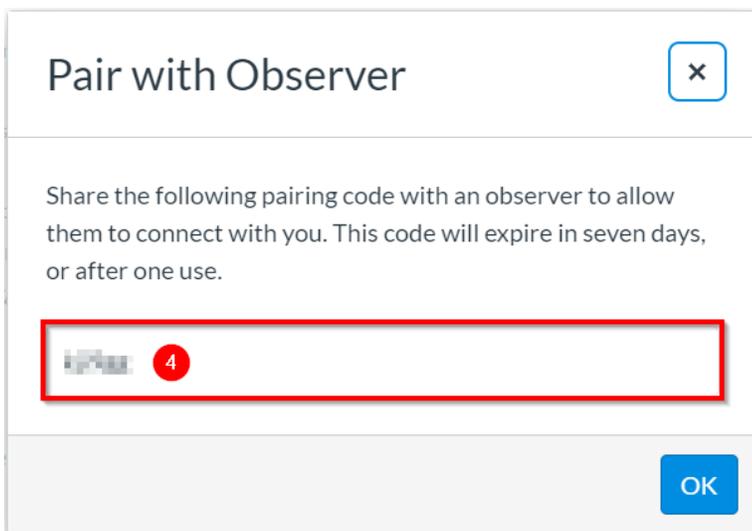

Get a Student Pairing Code

1. To get a pairing code for your student, first log in to their Canvas account.
2. Click on **Account** > **Settings** > **Pair with Observer**.



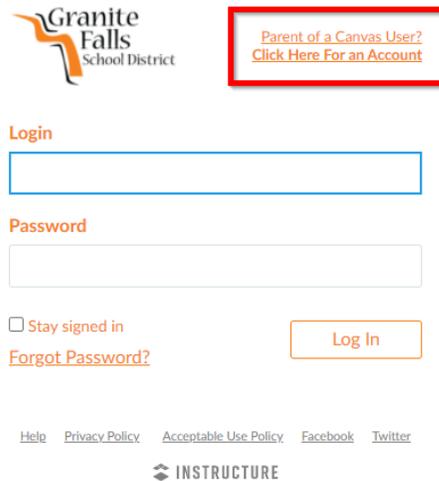
3. Copy or write down the pairing code for your student. You will need this to create an observer account.



Signing up for a Canvas Parent Account

1. Start by going to the GFSD Canvas site: <https://gfalls.instructure.com/>

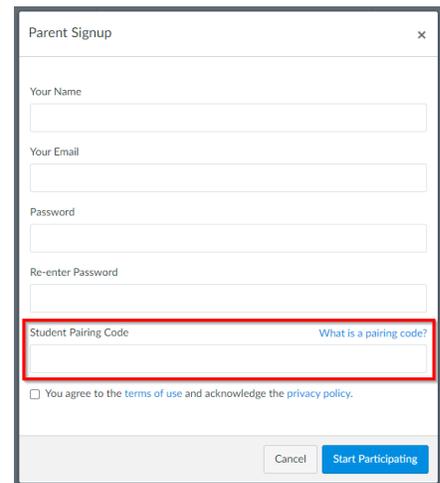
2. Click on the Canvas Parent logo to get to the login page, then click on **Parent of a Canvas User?** to create a parent account.



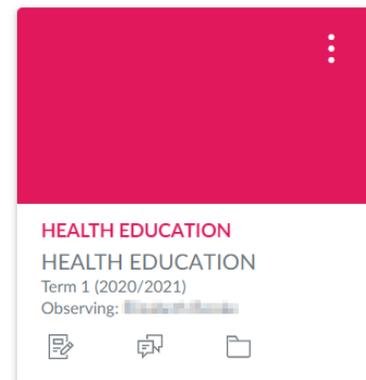
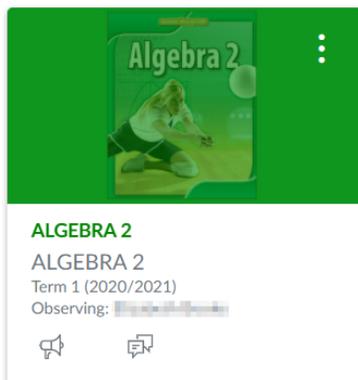
3. Sign up using your full name, email address, and a memorable password.

4. Finally, enter the pairing code you wrote down earlier from your student's account.

If you have multiple students, complete your account creation and then refer to the "Observing a Second Student" section below.



When you have completed this process successfully, you will see each of your child's courses on your dashboard. Each course card will have the student's observee's name.



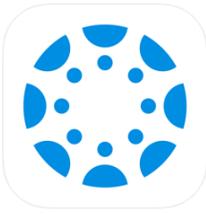
Observing a Second Student

1. To begin observing another student, you will need to log in to your Canvas Parent account on the web.
2. Once you have logged in, click on **Account > Observing**.

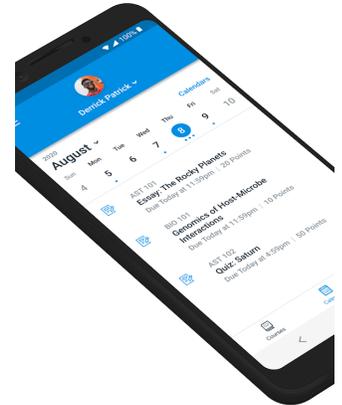

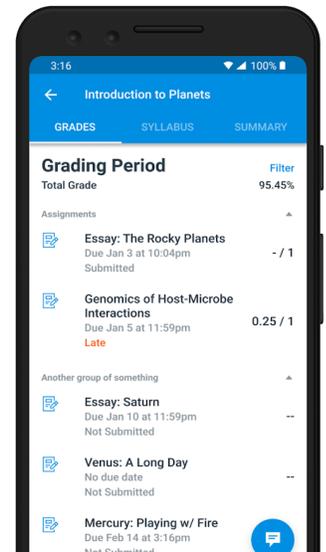
